First PLANNER was held at NEHU, Shilong, second at Manipur University, Imphal, third at Assam University, Silchar, fourth at Mizoram University, Aizawl and fifth in Guwahati University, Assam. This event has become popular not only in North East but also amongst professionals from rest of the country and the neighboring countries. After the overwhelming response and success of five PLANNERs, INFLIBNET is organizing PLANNER-2008 being 6th in the series, in collaboration with Nagaland University, at the School of Engineering & Technology and School of Management (SETAM), Dimapur, Nagaland during 6-7 November, 2008.

OBJECTIVES

- To define, conceptualize and provide a road-map for open libraries as information and knowledge Centres;
- To develop models for building open libraries using open source software;
- To explore features and functionalities of open source software suitable for academic libraries;
- To empower librarians and users through open access, open source and a network of open libraries;
- To explore possibilities of building open libraries around the UGC Infonet Digital Library and network infrastructure;
- To explore the feasibility of creating contents and hosting them in open access using open source software.

Programme committee solicits high quality technical papers relevant to the themes (but not limited to) and sub-themes given on the first page.

Papers typed in Open Office/MS-Word format can be sent as attachment addressed to Convener, PLANNER 2008 directly through E-Mail or in a floppy/CDROM by post. The length of the paper should normally be within 5000 words. Papers should contain full name and affiliations with e-mail of author(s), an abstract, author's biography and references properly cited in the text of article. The paper should neither be published anywhere nor should have been kept under consideration for publication elsewhere and the author should agree to transfer the copyright to the conference organizers.
